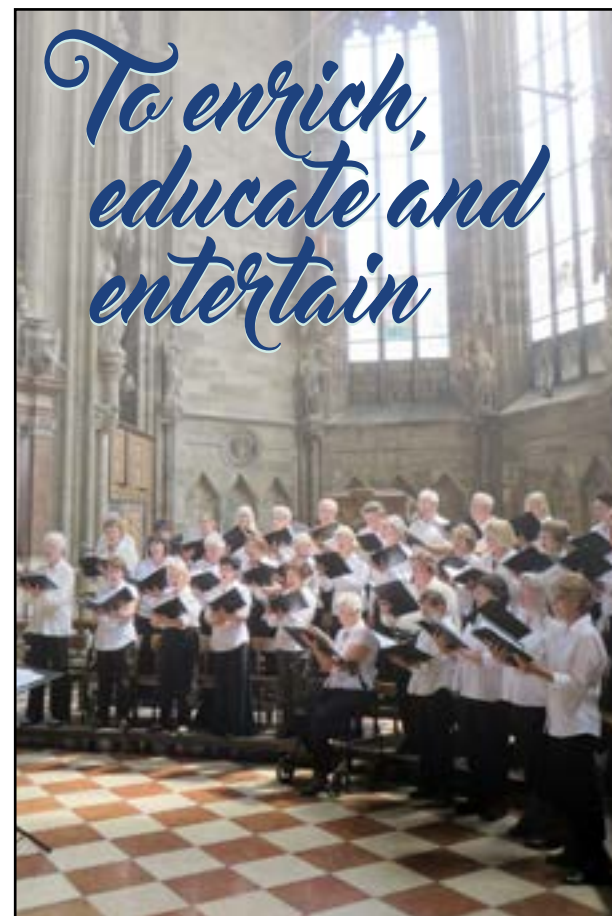
Artistic Team
